Call-Up Substitution Process

Saint Charles Youth Baseball would like to provide the opportunity for capable adjacent lower level players to be called up to play at the next level as temporary fill-in substitutions. This opportunity will give the player great insight to the next level.

Selection of Call-Up player:

- 1) Each Manager from Major, Minor, Bantam, Rookie will choose two players that he/she and coaches believe are most capable to play up to next league.
- 2) Parents of these selected players will be notified by Manager, and parents must approve the call-up possibility for their player.
- 3) If parent disapproves, Manager will select another player in progression of ability.
- 4) Once parent approves the call-up, Manager will submit names of selected player to their own leagues commissioner.
- 5) Commissioner will create a "pool of players" tracking which nights these players could be available for call-ups. Commissioner will rotate through pool players in a round robin type fashion making it fair for all selected in pool.

Process of requesting a Call-up player:

- 1) Manager will call lower league commissioner to request a player from that leagues pool. Manager will provide date/time/location of game that he needs a player(s).
- 2) Commissioner will find a pool player that is available for that date/time/location of game needed. Commissioner will call parent/player to approve and provide info on where that player is requested. Commissioner will then notify requesting Manager of player's info.

Example: Major Manager needs a call-up player on XX date. Major Manager will call Minor commissioner to procure a player for game. Minor commissioner will provide players info to requesting Manager.

Rules:

- No Call-up player shall pitch in call-up game.
- No Call-up player shall catch in call-up game.
- Call-up player will wear home league uniform.
- Call-up player cannot miss a scheduled home league game for a call-up game.
- If manager plays a Non-Pool player for a substitution, game will be forfeited and not count in standings. Game will not be made up.
